## **School Development Plan – Actions for Learning Excellence**

## Actions Identified in the SDP for Learning Excellence:

- Explicit Instruction using UFLI program to improve phonological awareness and decode text
- Intentional teaching of "I Can" statements to support students' understanding of learning intentions
- Utilize texts that highlight the concept of belonging





## School Development Plan – Actions for Well-Being

### **Actions Identified in the SDP for Well-Being:**

- Use of CASEL Framework
- Use the student assessment results to design literacy tasks that address the needs of all learners
- Teachers will explicitly teach Social Emotional Learning in relation to sense of belonging and reading identity





## School Development Plan – Actions for Truth & Reconciliation, Diversity and Inclusion

## Actions Identified in the SDP for Truth & Reconciliation, Diversity and Inclusion

- Collection of Indigenous student stories to know our learners
- Low floor, high ceiling literacy task design allowing for multiple entry points for all learners
- Intentional use of culturally diverse texts to build understanding, awareness and student sense of belonging.


