## How is Our School Development Plan Used?

- Guides ongoing assessment and review of goals and actions.
- Our school development plan is the driver for closing learning gaps and informs:
  - Instructional strategies
  - Professional learning
  - School structures and processes for learning
  - Resources to improve student learning
  - Data-informed decision making

# School Development Plan – School Goal



- **Our School Goal is:**
  - ***Task design and targeted intervention will improve academic achievement and well-being.***



## School Development Plan – Outcome

- **Our SDP Outcomes Include:**
- ***Student reading will improve***
- ***Student sense of belonging will improve***





## School Development Plan – Outcome Measures



- Our SDP Outcome Measures Include:
- *Data from Provincial Literacy Assessment*
- *Our School Survey – Well-Being*
- *Alberta Education Assurance Measures*
- *English as an Additional Language Learner (LP1 Reading) Cohort Letter Name, Sound, & High Frequency Words*
- *Internal Well-Being Survey (grade 1-3)*

# School Development Plan – Data for Monitoring Progress



- **SDP Data for Monitoring Progress Includes:**
- *Early Learning Assessments/Decision Tree*
- *Professional Learning Community (PLC) teacher reflections and student tracking*
- *Gr. 4 OurSchool Survey Data for Fall & Spring*
- *Indigenous Student Story Tracking*

# School Development Plan – Actions



- **Actions Identified in the SDP for Learning Excellence:**
- Engage students in targeted instruction to improve phonological awareness, decoding, and fluency
- Intentional teaching of “I Can” statements to support students’ understanding of learning intentions
- Utilize texts that highlight the concept of belonging, self-awareness and self-management

# School Development Plan



- **Actions Identified in the SDP for Well-Being:**
  - Use of CASEL Framework
  - Use the student assessment results and CBE guiding documents to design tasks that address the needs of all learners
  - Teachers will explicitly teach Social Emotional Learning in relation to sense of belonging, self-awareness, and self-management

# School Development Plan



- **Actions Identified in the SDP for Truth & Reconciliation, Diversity and Inclusion**
- Collection of Indigenous student stories to know our learners
- Low floor, high ceiling literacy task design allowing for multiple entry points for all learners
- Intentional use of culturally diverse texts to build understanding, awareness and student sense of belonging.


